



Visiting Speakers Agreement at Newstead Wood School

We understand the importance of visitors and external agencies to enrich the experiences of our students.

In order to safeguard our children, we expect all visiting speakers to read and adhere to the statements below.

- Any messages communicated to pupils support fundamental British Values and our school values.
- Any messages communicated to pupils do not marginalise any communities, groups or individuals.
- Any messages communicated to pupils do not seek to glorify criminal activity or violent extremism or seek to radicalise pupils through extreme or narrow views of faith, religion, culture, or other ideologies.
- Activities and presentations are matched to the ability, need, and age of the students involved, while not restricting access to younger students from the opportunity to challenge themselves.

In the unlikely event that a visiting speaker breaks this agreement, then the teacher listening must immediately inform the Designated Safeguarding Lead and/or the Headteacher and/or the Assistant Headteacher responsible for Visiting Speakers, who will terminate the speaker. All visiting speakers will be informed of this before they start speaking.
