The exams will benefit students who are keen on honing their acting skills; those who want to gain public speaking confidence, and interview technique. They are a very instructive complement to literary studies and cover all aspects of voice production as well as interpretation and analysis.

In today's competitive world, how you present and express yourself is a vitally important skill to possess, not just in school, but also later in life. Those who learn vocal and presentation skills early in their lives have a great advantage.

Competing for university places and the workplace has become increasingly difficult. Studying elocution, voice production and taking LAMDA exams do not involve writing but teach vitally important life skills such as public speaking, presentation technique, voice projection and clear diction. These skills are taught in a fun and exciting curriculum and through the creative disciplines of, for example:

Learners can obtain UCAS tariff points at Level 3, enhancing their chances of university or higher education entrance. Level 3 is available for students in Year 10 and above. LAMDA lessons and exam preparation time can also be used for the skills section of the Duke of Edinburgh's award.

Classes take place in school, Monday to Thursday from 3.40pm until 5.00pm or 5.30pm. Day classes and Zoom lessons can also be scheduled.

LAMDA After School Group Standard Class - 3.40pm-5.00pm

Price: £192 per 12-week term.

The standard class focuses on voice production, elocution and acting.

Acting is mandatory in the after school standard classes.

Public Speaking is an optional extra as part of the standard classes above.

Preparation for public speaking will begin with four private zoom lessons. This is to make sure students are fully prepared and understand the exam requirements. Feedback will be given in the private zoom lessons. The cost of the four private lessons will be an additional one-off charge of £120. Students will then continue to practice their performances and vocal skills in the standard after school classes.

Students wishing to take public speaking only, will need to sign up for the lunchtime classes.

Exam sessions are held in May, June and July.
