BYMT TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR MUSIC LESSONS

Licensed Teachers supplied through BYMT are not employees or workers but are in business of their own account. Your licensed teachers will store your data in accordance with GDPR guidance and share it with Bromley Youth Music Trust as the licensing body who may contact you with relevant musical opportunities.

LESSONS

- 1. BYMT reserves the right to provide your child with a different teacher should the need arise.
- 2. Your licensed teacher will normally deliver 30 lessons per academic year in school or at a BYMT rehearsal venue (an average of 10 lessons per term). However, if you would like additional lessons these may be arranged through agreement with the teacher at the pro-rota teaching rate.
- 3. Lessons missed by pupils will not be credited unless a minimum of a week's notice has been given to the teacher. There will be no credit for holiday taken by pupils during a term.
- 4. Should a lesson be cancelled due to circumstances beyond the control of the teacher (eg. school closure due to snow) they will take all reasonable steps to make it up. However, there is no guarantee that this will be possible.
- In the event of a school closure lasting more than two weeks, and with the agreement of the school, alternative arrangements can be made between the teacher and payer to provide online tuition, reschedule lessons, or not invoice.
- 6. Lessons must not take place at the home of the student or teacher in any circumstances.
- 7. The licensed teacher may supply you with a BYMT approved substitute teacher from time to time and will liaise with you accordingly.
- 8. If you wish to discontinue lessons, written notice must be given to the licensed teacher by the last school day before half term, lessons will then be provided until the end of that term. However,
 - If you give notice at the start of a term you will be liable for that term's fee.
 - If you give notice after the last day before half-term you will be liable for the following term's fee (Autumn and Spring Terms only).
 - If you give notice after the Summer half-term, you will only be charged half a term's fee in lieu of notice.
- 9. Licensed teachers reserve the rights to discontinue lessons. If you wish for your child to continue learning, BYMT will endeavour to offer alternative tuition options.

PAYMENTS

- 10. Fees will be reviewed annually. Invoices will be issued termly.
- 11. Fees are due in advance at the start of each term and must be made within 14 days of receiving an invoice. If payment is not made within this 14-day period, the licensed teacher reserves the right to suspend any further lessons until payment is received and will pursue the debt. Lessons missed through late payment of fees will not be made up or refunded.
- 12. Parent/Carers must pay for music and external examination fees (upon agreement) also accessories such as strings, rosin and reeds.
