### **Fantasy Wings**

Fantasy Wings are committed to changing the statistics and creating more opportunities for BAME and Female students to become Airline Pilot's and Aviation Professionals.

They run a 10-month Aviation programme which teaches young people how to become professional pilots and all about the world of Aviation, from Engineering to Aviation Leadership.

At the end of the programme, three young people will receive the cost of training for their 45-hour Private Pilot Licence & the exam for their Private Pilot License funded by Fantasy Wings. 50 additional students of the 21/22 programme will receive a trial flying lesson fully funded by Fantasy Wings.

It will run on one Saturday a month, beginning this October for 10 months and will be delivered by Airline Pilots, Aviation Professionals and Industry Leaders. It is open to students from age 13-25.
