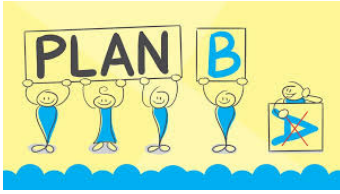

Life is unpredictable so its important to have a plan B for your career.

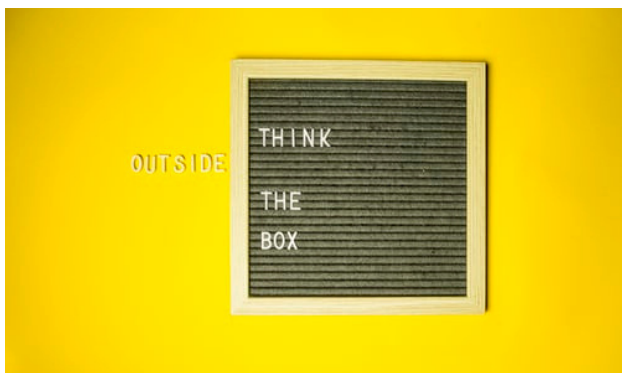

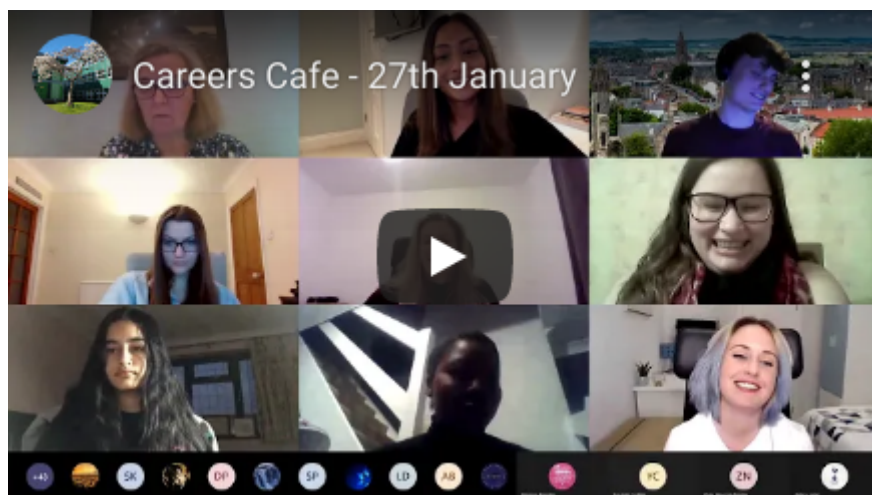
