

YEAR 7-11 SCHOOL UNIFORM

OUTDOOR WEAR

- Coat** A smart coat in black/cream or grey
Leather/PVC/denim coats and jackets are not allowed
Hoodies and sweatshirts are not acceptable as coats
- Scarf** Plain dark green or black or school colours
- Gloves** Plain dark green or black
- School Bags** All students should have a **plain black** bag suitable for carrying books and equipment in all weathers, no logos or designs. A small black bag with straps no bigger than A5 size can be used to carry valuables

INDOOR WEAR

(Lower School)

Jacket Bottle Green jacket with School Badge on lapel which must be worn at all times

Skirt A regulation dark green kilt or A line skirt. **Skirts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee when kneeling**

(Upper School)

Jacket Black Eco-Blazer with school badge on lapel which must be worn at all times.

Skirt A black kilt or A line skirt. **Skirts should be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee when kneeling**

(Y7 -11)

Trousers Regulation black **Banner** trousers (3 styles available)

Blouse A regulation green and white blouse (either long or short sleeves)

Jumper **A regulation green jumper, V-necked, with a yellow stripe and school badge**

Socks Ankle or Knee Length Black socks, or **plain** black or clear tights, no patterns. **Over the knee socks or stockings/hold ups are not permitted.** White socks are allowed in the summer

Shoes **Plain, black** wide-heeled shoes (heels no higher than 2 inches), leather or other hard material. **"Kickers" style ankle-boots, "creepers" with thick soles, boots, sandals and trainers are not allowed.** If boots are worn to school in bad weather students must change into shoes in school

JEWELLERY

The following items **only** are allowed:

- A simple, small cross and chain (or equivalent)
- One plain narrow ring
- Small, plain studs one per ear in the lobe, gold or silver only, no diamante or other material
- A wrist watch may also be worn

For safety reasons **no jewellery** can be worn in PE lessons

The school cannot be responsible for any jewellery lost at school

MAKE UP AND HAIR

Hair Accessories should be plain black or dark green. Extreme hairstyles and hair colours which are not natural are also unacceptable. No shaved or partially shaved heads. Sanctions will be applied as necessary.

Make up and nail polish are not allowed in Year 7, 8 and 9.

In Year 10 and 11 discreet make-up and clear, not coloured, nail varnish is permitted. (Brightly coloured eye shadow, heavy eye-liner, lipstick and coloured nail polish are not considered discreet). Students will be asked to remove make-up thought to be unsuitable for school.

OVERALLS

Science and D&T

- A green overall is required which can be worn for both Science and DT. The overall must be named on the **inside** with a **name tape**.
- A white lab coat may be worn by **Year 10** students and above for Science.

Art & Pottery

- Students are asked to wear a shirt or blue overall to protect their uniforms, but **not** their Science/D&T overall

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Black School tracksuit trousers with school logo and/or leggings with school logo (Chadwick Trousers – Skinny Pants 826, Leggings – Female Academy Leggings 838)
- Black hoody with school logo (this will be purchased from Newstead directly)
- Black and green polo shirt with school logo (Chadwick – Igen Unisex Polo Black/Bottle)
- Black and green games skort and/or shorts with school logo (Chadwick – Igen Skort Black/Bottle, Igen Unisex shorts Black/Bottle)
- Black cycle shorts
- Long green socks
- Trainers
- White ankle socks
- Astro-boots – not studded
- Shin pads
- House T Shirt – colour according to House
- Gum Shield
- School PE Bag – colour according to House
- Combination Padlock for PE Bag (Optional)

All other PE equipment must be named with a name tape on the inside.

In addition:

- A towel and spare carrier bag are useful in wet weather

All jewellery must be removed for all PE lessons. **PLEASE DO NOT get ears pierced during the school term as earrings must be removed for lessons. Taping over earrings is not permitted.** All students should be able to remove their own earrings for lessons.

Gymnastic work is done in bare feet, but any girl with athlete's foot or a verruca should bring a note from home for her PE teacher.

Embroidering the name of the student on clothing is no longer expected as they will be wearing kit to and from school and this is to ensure our students' safety that they are not easily identified.

All other kit can be purchased outside of the school uniform shops, although the full kit except the hoody is available to purchase from both Graduates and Hewitt's if necessary.
