- 3) Research the Wenlock Games and how it influenced Sporting competitions today.
- 4) If possible, gather footage of a you competing in your sport in a full sided game/full competition (if not then let us know when you will be able to do this at some point in Year 12)

How the work produced will fit into subsequent work and the specification as a whole

This will be needed for Section A, B and C— Anatomy and Physiology, Skill Acquisition and Sociology of Sport of their A Level.

How the work should be presented
