1D – Stuart Britain and the Crisis of Monarchy 1603-1702

- 1. You should purchase the CT for the start of term <u>Crisis of Stuart Britain</u> Read the <u>scanned</u> <u>textbook pages</u>, make a note of the key words and their definitions in the boxes, and answer the questions in the 'Q' boxes on pgs. 12, 13 and 14.
- 2. Listen to the podcasts about <u>Calvinism</u> and the <u>Divine Right of Kings</u>. Use these and the information from the scanned pages to answer the following questions in note form:
 - a. Why was this a period of religious conflict?
 - b. How did religious issues create political conflict in Britain?

You should make sure that you are supporting the points that you are making with specific evidence.

3. Read a copy of *Stuart Britain: A Very Short Introduction'* - This is a very good, brief overview of the Stuart that I highly recommend! It is only a short read and there are normally copies in bookshops or you can buy a used copy online.

- 2. Please read China
- 3. Prepare half a page of notes on Confucianism.
- 4. Read a copy of Jung Chang's Wild Swans: Three Daughters of China. It was a bestseller in the 1990s so your parents or their friends may well have a copy at home. Otherwise, there are normally copies in charity shops or you can buy a used copy online.
