Dear Sixth Form Students, Parents and Carers

Public Health Alert: Drug-related Deaths

We have been asked by Bromley Public Health to share the attached information with our Sixth Form students and parents/carers.

Over the Bank Holiday weekend, two people were found dead in Southall, Ealing, following attendance at a nightclub in South London on Saturday 24 May. They are believed to have taken green pills.

The key message from the Public Health Authority is that there are pills in circulation in the Southeast of England that have been linked to a number of deaths. These pills are potentially fatal, even in small amounts. **People should be advised not to take pills at all**, rather than to initially take small amounts as is the usual harm reduction advice.
