## Year 11 Trip to 'Bacchae' at the National Theatre – Wednesday 1 October

I'm delighted to let you know that we are leading an evening trip to the National Theatre on Wednesday 1 October to watch their new production of 'Bacchae'.

This is a new adaptation of the Euripides tragedy by Nima Taleghani (of *Heartstopper* fame) which promises to be a tremendously exciting night. The production reimagines this Greek tragedy for the twenty-first century.

**Please note**: This production contains graphic depictions of violence and death, scenes of a sexual nature, sexual references, ableism, strong language and loud music with heavy bass. It's recommended for ages 14+

Tickets will be on sale until **Tuesday 3 June** and a limited number of tickets are available. We would love as many Year 10 students as possible to take part, as it will be a chance for a great night out to celebrate making a great start to Year 11!
