Managing Seasonal Illness and Supporting Good Attendance this Winter

As we move further into the winter term, we would like to share some important guidance on managing seasonal illness while continuing to support strong attendance at school. We fully recognise that winter brings an increase in coughs, colds and other common illnesses, and we want to work closely with you to keep our community as healthy as possible.

The Department for Education has recently reminded schools and families of key national guidance to help reduce the spread of illness while ensuring that pupils only miss school when genuinely unwell. Two particularly helpful resources for parents are:
