



Drug Alert Drug health harms in London and harm reduction messages



Overview of the Situation

Over the Bank Holiday weekend, 2 people were found dead in Southall, Ealing, following attendance at a nightclub in South London on Saturday 24th May. They are thought to have consumed green pills with an '80' on one face and possibly an 'OP' on the other face but they were poorly made and faded. A picture is available above of remaining pills which were seized by police. We don't know what type of drugs the people thought they were buying.

- The pills have been found to contain a potent synthetic opioid.
- The pills could be marketed and sold as a range of different drugs.

Harm Reduction Messages

- Green pills are being sold in London which may contain a lethal dose of a synthetic opioid.
- Other pills with different designs or colours may also contain harmful adulterants.
- Usual harm reduction advice to use small amounts first is **NOT** applicable, as even a smaller amount could be fatal. If you do use drugs, do not take them when you are alone.
- If you or someone else feel unwell after consuming drugs, please seek emergency medical attention, rather than waiting to see if the effects wear off after sleep and re-hydration.
- Have naloxone to hand. This opioid overdose antidote works on synthetic opioids so have it
 to hand if you're going to put yourself at risk. You can get it from your nearest drug service.
