## Year 9 GCSE Options Evening - Wednesday 31 January 2024

The Year 9 Options Evening will take place on **Wednesday 31 January 2024 at 6.00pm**. The evening is designed to provide students and parents with all the information you need to make an informed choice before the deadline of **Friday 1 March 2024**.

The Year 9 Options Evening is to supplement the information provided in the attached booklet, which is also available on the <u>school website</u>, and includes an options guide and information from Heads of Department for optional subjects.

All students will take the Core Subjects of English Language, English Literature, Mathematics, Science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics), RPE (Religion, Philosophy and Ethics) and PE (non-GCSE subject).

Students choose an additional <u>three subjects</u> to take at GCSE from the list below:

- Art Graphic Communication
- Art and Design Textiles
- Fine Art
- Computer Science
- Design and Technology
- Drama
- Engineering
- Food Preparation and Nutrition
- Geography
- History
- Modern Foreign Languages French, German and Spanish
- Music
- Physical Education

Students will study 10 GCSE subjects. Any additional GCSE twilight courses need to be agreed with the twilight class teacher and Head of Year.
