Leadership at Newstead Wood School

Mr Norman is an extremely experienced leader who has worked in senior roles across three of United Learning's independent schools as well as at the City of London Freemen's School.

Currently Deputy Head at our Ashford School, Mr Norman knows this area extremely well and understands the expectations of parents and the reputation that Newstead Wood enjoys as an exceptional school. Mr Norman will take up post on 5th January and very much looks forward to meeting students and parents over the course of his first few weeks in post.


