Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 7 Residential Trip to Eleven Acres Scout Camp, Downe – 11-12 July 2024

I am happy to announce that Newstead Wood School will be putting on a summer 'Bushcraft and Survival' camp at Eleven Acres campsite, in nearby Downe (BR6 7JT). This two-day, one night camping trip is a fantastic opportunity for students to learn the vital skills of survival, and to test them in the wild.

The students will come away with a deeper understanding of their own abilities outside the classroom, and they will learn to control themselves and think on their feet when placed outside their comfort zones.

Some of the valuable skills taught include shelter building, first aid and personal responsibility. They will also learn fire craft and knife craft – learning how to use a knife as a tool, not as a toy or a weapon. Lessons on the law are included. Students will be shown proper use and good practice with a knife, and all knives will be given out and taken in by staff for the duration of the camp.

Students will become skilled and responsible with these skills during their stay. They also learn search and rescue techniques, outdoor cooking, wild food foraging, primitive weapon construction and use, animal tracking, teamwork and leadership skills. The idea is to have lots of fun whilst learning essential skills.

The provider company for this is Polaris Outdoor Ltd. They are an LOTC certified company, which provides the highest level of safety and competency in the UK, certified by UK governing bodies. It is important that staff have up to date contact information for your daughter, should we need to contact you during the trip (or at any time during school hours). We also require all relevant Medical Information. A Microsoft form was recently sent to all year 7 parents, asking that you sign and agree to the Newstead Code of Conduct which covers all trips, so please ensure this is done. In addition, to ensure trip safety, we take all emergency contact and medical information from the school database. Please check the Arbor app and update the school with any changes, as a matter of urgency.

Students must prepare for this trip by having a sleeping bag, sleeping mat, waterproof clothing, a warm hat and a torch, preferably a head torch. Please see the kit list below.

As outlined in Mr Bournat's letter regarding Cultural Arts Week, the cost of this residential trip is £150, included within the £210 cost of Cultural Arts and Careers Week. The suggested instalments are outlined below:
